



Press release

In the framework of the collaboration process provided by Productos Tissue del Perú S.A. (Protisa), a subsidiary of CMPC, in the investigation carried out by the peruvian National Institute for the Defense of Competition and Protection of Intellectual Property (Indecopi), the company complies with the following:

1. Protisa recognizes the facts denounced and will not appeal to the conclusions or sanctions determined by Indecopi, that means an estimated fine of 13.5 million dollars.
2. We restate our strongest rejection of the practices referred to in the Indecopi report, which were self-reported by Protisa as soon as its board became aware of facts contrary to free competition, providing full cooperation throughout the investigation process.
3. The investigation carried out by Indecopi is part of the same and unique internal investigation process developed by CMPC from the very first moment in which the company's Board of Directors became aware of indications of anomalies and which resulted in self-reports in Peru And Chile.
4. Indecopi's resolution implies the definitive term of the process that involved Protisa.
5. CMPC has implemented, both at the corporate level and in its local operations, a series of measures aimed at avoiding situations such as those reported, including changes in corporate and executive governance, the generation of new controls, the hiring of specialized consulting services to implement the best global practices, and the training in free competition and good practices to all the people who are part of the company.
