

## June 2025 CMPC's Statement of Compliance with the European Union Regulation on Deforestation (EUDR 2023/1115)

CMPC, hereinafter referred to as "the Company" has adopted appropriate measures to ensure that its products comply with the requirements of legality, free of deforestation and degradation, established in Regulation (EU) 2023/1115, hereinafter referred to as "the Regulation", which will enter into force on 30 December, 2025. These actions include the implementation of a due diligence system that includes collecting, presenting and retaining records and information on the origin and suppliers of raw materials and other products that it markets, as well as evaluations, procedures and other measures to reduce and effectively manage the risks identified. An overview of this system can be found here.

The aforementioned system is part of an integrated model in CMPC's value chain whose purpose is to guarantee sustainable forest management, including chain of custody and controlled wood, as well as the legality, traceability and control of origin of the wood with which it is supplied. This is achieved, among others, through adherence to demanding sustainable forest management standards, through different global certification initiatives and independent audits, including compliance with strict principles in direct forestry operations, as well as through requesting full compliance from indirect operations. CMPC's community relationship strategy is also part of this model, which, based on different principles and actions, seeks to create shared value for the different stakeholders with which the Company is associated.

In addition, CMPC has implemented an Integrity Program which, through various standards and controls, makes effective the Company's commitment against all forms of corruption and bribery, as well as the total respect and promotion of free and fair competition in the different markets in which it operates and conducts its business. Accordingly, the Company has adopted a Code of Ethics which presents its corporate purpose and values, as well as Integrity Policies (Corporate Probity & Free Competition), Environment, Human Rights and Diversity and Inclusion, among others, all of which are available to view at <u>www.cmpc.com</u>.
